

Terms and Conditions – Face of The Hunter Competition

1. Promoter

- 1.1 The promoter of this competition is Newcastle Jockey Club ABN 13 000 002 513 of 100 Darling Street, Broadmeadow NSW 2292 ("Promoter").
- By entering this competition, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

2. Eligibility

- Entry is open to residents of Australia aged 18 years or over.
- Employees, contractors, and immediate families of the Promoter and its related entities are ineligible to enter.
- The Promoter reserves the right to verify the eligibility of entrants and may disqualify entries that do not comply with these Terms and Conditions.

3. Competition Period

- Entries open at 11:00am AEST on Saturday, 20 September 2025 and close at 11:59pm AEST on Sunday, 12 October 2025 ("Competition Period").
- Entries received outside the Competition Period will not be accepted.

4. How to Enter

- To enter, entrants must complete the official online entry form available via the Newcastle Racecourse website during the Competition Period.
- Each entry must include at least one recent photograph of the entrant and a short written biography explaining why they should be the Face of The Hunter.
- Only one entry per person is permitted.
- Entries that are incomplete, indecipherable, or do not comply with these Terms and Conditions will be deemed invalid.

5. Judging and Finalists

- This competition is a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winners.
- A judging panel appointed by the Promoter will assess entries based on style, personality, creativity, and alignment with the Newcastle Racecourse brand.
- Finalists will be contacted directly by the Promoter between 25 30 October 2025.
- The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

6. Winner Announcement

- One male and one female winner (together, the "Winners") will be selected from the finalists.
- The Winners will be showcased on Saturday, 15 November 2025 at The Hunter Race Day held at Newcastle Racecourse.
- The Winners will also be notified directly by the Promoter using the contact details provided at entry.



7. Prize

- Each Winner will receive:
 - a \$1,000 aift card; and
 - appointment as the official "Face of The Hunter 2026" ambassador role.
 - The total prize pool is valued at \$2,000 (inclusive of GST).
 - The prize is not transferable, exchangeable, or redeemable for cash.

8. Ambassador Role

- As part of the prize, each Winner will be required to:
 - attend The Hunter Race Day 2026 and other key Newcastle Racecourse feature race days throughout 2026 as determined by the Promoter;
 - participate in official photoshoots, social media, promotional campaigns, and media appearances as reasonably required by the Promoter;
 - positively represent the Newcastle Racecourse brand in public and across personal social media platforms; and
 - attend each event with 2 x complimentary tickets provided by the Promoter.
- Failure to fulfil the ambassador obligations may result in forfeiture of the role and/or prize at the discretion of the Promoter.
